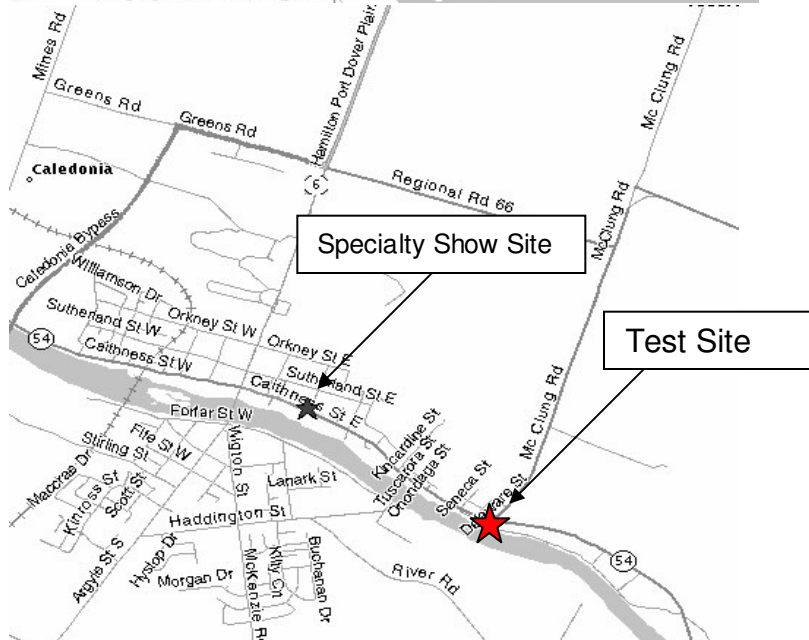
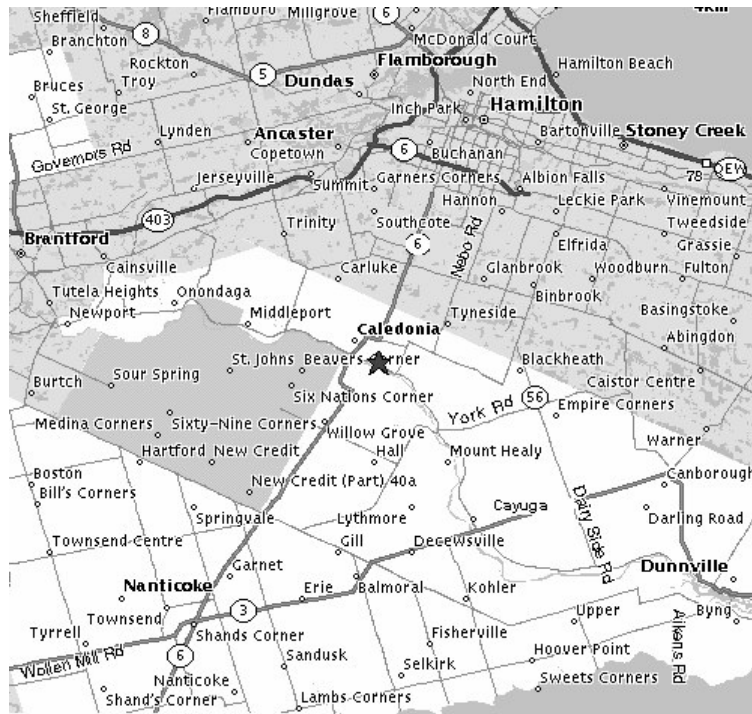

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Draft Test Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club (Tel: 416-675-5511)

As per the Draft Dog Test Rules and Regulations:

The group option as stated in section 11.2 is not offered at this test.

Regulation 17.6 states; Any person, either within or outside the judging area, who does anything calculated to attract, distract or otherwise interferes in any way with attention, deportment, or performance of a dog under judgment, may be disciplined by the Discipline Committee in whatever way it considers to be in the best interest of the club, or the judge may take summary action.

Regulation 17.7 states; It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, steward, volunteer or competitor at a Draft Dog Test is not subject to indignities. The Draft Dog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching the Test Secretary after the official closing date as published in the premium list or after the maximum number of entries has been received.

No Entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are shown thereon. Incomplete entries will be returned.

No Entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fee. Telephone, fax and tele-graph entries cannot be accepted.

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Cancellations of any entry after the closing day are prohibited.

The Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Ontario reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Rules.

Identification and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after entries close.

NOTICE TO ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS FROM THE CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB

Event Registration Number (ERN)

Every foreign born and owned dog that is entered in a Canadian Kennel Club event must obtain an Event Registration Number (ERN). An Event Registration Number Application must be completed and submitted along with a copy of registration documents from a CKC recognized foreign kennel club and the required fee.

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

- **Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN number or completed ERN form**
- **ERN forms are available on line at: <http://www.ckc.ca/forms/pdf/150-14-50.pdf> or by contacting the CKC Order Desk at 1-800-250-8040**
- **Fee payment of \$53.50 Cdn for each dog is payable by Visa, Mastercard, money order or certified cheque. Payment in full to be made in Canadian dollars and payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. Discounted cheques in US dollars will not be accepted due to fluctuating exchange rates.**
- **Provide the CKC with your full return address.**

An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibits this or presents a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension.

Canada-US Border Crossing: Canadian Government regulations require that to be brought into Canada a dog must have a valid Rabies Certificate of Vaccination. It is recommended that your dog be vaccinated at least 30 days prior to arriving in Canada.
