NOTICE TO FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Every foreign born and owned dog that is entered in a Canadian Kennel Club event must obtain an Event Registration Number (ERN). An Event Registration Number Application must be completed and submitted along with a copy of registration documents from a CKC recognized foreign kennel club and the required fee.

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

- Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN number or completed ERN form.
- ERN Forms are available on line at <http://www.ckc.ca/forms/pdf/150-14-50.pdf> or by contacting the CKC Order Desk at 1.800.250.8040
- Fee payment of \$53.50 Cdn for each dog is payable by Visa, MasterCard, money order or certified cheque. Payment in full to be made in Canadian dollars and payable to The Canadian Kennel Club. Discounted cheques in US dollars will not be accepted due to fluctuating exchange rates.
- Provide a full return address.

- Faxed requests will be accepted. Please ensure that your Visa or Mastercard number is legible and you have included the expiry date and signature.

An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or presents a problem, please send a written request for 30 day extension.

Canada-US Border Crossing: Canadian Government regulations require that to be brought into Canada a dog must have a valid Rabies Certificate of Vaccination. It is recommended that your dog be vaccinated at least 30 days prior to arriving in Canada.

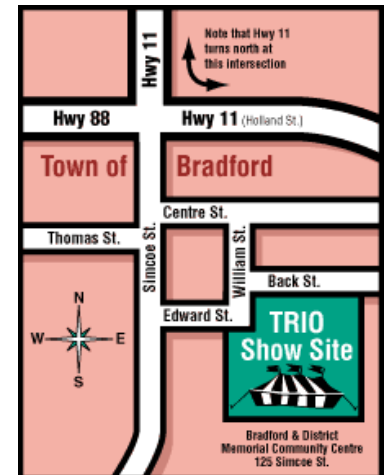
1. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the official closing date as published in the premium list.

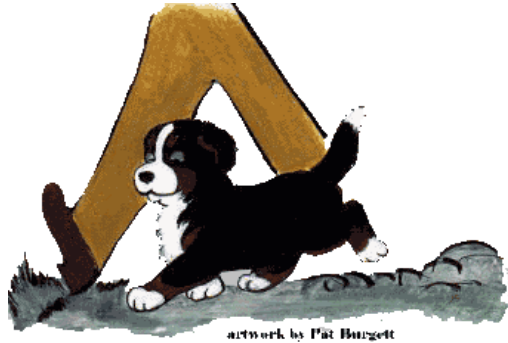

Conformation dog show judging in North America is both a competitive and comparative process. The Judge compares each dog to the others in the ring, then picks the best four in each class and ranks them. The first place dog in each class then compete against each other for Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, then Best of Winners, Best Opposite Sex and Best of Breed. The Judge does not provide either a written or verbal critique explaining his/her choices.

In a Sieger Show, however, each dog enters the ring individually and is evaluated and given a score based on how closely it measures to the **ideal dog** in the breed standard and not ranked or compared against the other dogs in its class. Ring procedure is relatively relaxed and informal. Each dog will receive a thorough hands on examination and is evaluated standing naturally and gaiting on a loose lead. The Judge is a knowledgeable breeder of Bernese Mountain Dogs and will provide both a verbal and written evaluation of the dog. Each dog is given an overall rating (outlined below). After all the dogs have been evaluated, only those dogs that were rated **Excellent** (there can be several from the same class) are brought back into the ring together and the Judge chooses Best Male in Sieger and Best Female in Sieger. The Best in Sieger Show is then chosen from these two.

Altered dogs as well as intact dogs are equally welcome in the ring. This show is a relaxed affair, so sit back, learn & enjoy the experience. Everyone is welcome.

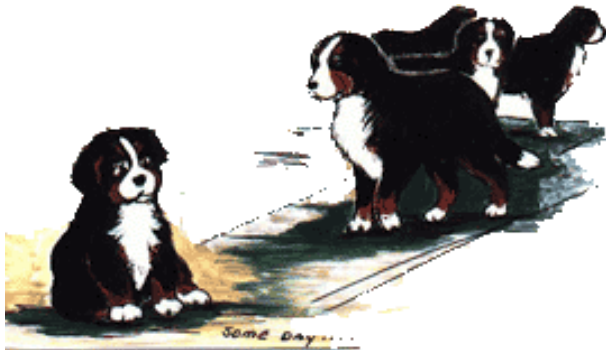

SPECIALTY CONFORMATION

Judge: Mary Alice Eschweiler (USA)

Regular Classes: Junior Puppy, Senior Puppy, 12-15 Months, 15-18 Months, Canadian Bred, Bred By Exhibitor, Open, Veterans, Specials Only, Exhibition Only.

Unofficial Classes: Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace

Sexually Altered Classes (separate classes for dogs and bitches)

The Judge will use the following ratings:

Excellent: For dogs shown in outstanding condition with a breed specific temperament and meeting the requirements of the standard to a nearly ideal extent. Dogs who show the greatest perfection in form and come closest to the ideal type.

Very Good: For dogs which conform to the breed characteristics in a high degree and whose anatomical structure is nearly free of faults, but which in spite of noble and noteworthy form, do not attain the highest qualifications of Excellent.

Good: For dogs meeting the main requirements of the standard to sufficient extent, showing several minor or a few more important faults or for dogs not in the desired condition.

Poor: For dogs not meeting the breed specific requirements of the standard to a sufficient degree and/or in poor condition.

How the Classes are Divided in a Sieger Show

Jugstklasse (Youngest) This class is for all dogs 15 mths of age & younger. In this class the puppies will receive an overall critique. The Jugstklasse critique is not as extensive as the one for the older dogs due to the changes that often occur as the dog matures. The puppies will be rated as Very Promising, Promising and Unacceptable. This class of dogs should be full of fun and that is not to be discouraged.

Jugendklasse (Youth) This class is for dogs 15-18 mths of age. These dogs will likely continue to mature.

Offenklasse (Open) This class is for dogs 18 mths or older that have not yet received a Championship title. Many of these dogs will be in the prime of their life, but may not have been shown much and may lack the steadiness that the Siegerklasse dogs will have.

Siegerklasse (Specials) This class is for dogs that have attained a recognized championship (i.e. CKC, AKC). These dogs will likely be mature dogs with a steady demeanor in the show ring.

Veteranklasse (Veterans) This class is for any dog over 7 years of age. These older dogs may have some grey around the face and present the maturity of mind and body, although they always seem to retain some puppy like behaviour.

Classes: (The classes are divided by age and sex)

Jungstenklasse: (Youngest) for dogs 15 months off age and younger.

Jugendklasse: (Youth) - for dogs 15-18 months of age.

Offen Klasse: (Open) - for dogs 18 months or older that have not yet received a Championship title.

Siegerklasse: (Specials) - for dogs with a recognized championship ie, CKC/AKC

Veteranenklasse: (Veterans) - for dogs 7 years and older

Note: Altered dogs as well as intact dogs are equally welcome to participate.

Closing date for entries will be July 25th 2004 - entries will be limited.

DESCRIPTION OF CLASSES (cont..)

Specialty Non-Regular CONFORMATION CLASSES:

* **Sweepstakes:** for Bernese Mountain Dogs 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

* **Veteran Sweepstakes:** Bernese Mountain Dogs must be 7 years of age and older

* **Three Generation Sweepstakes:** Entry consists of three Bernese Mountain Dogs in a 3 generation DIRECT line (eg. Mother--son/daughter--grandson/granddaughter or Father--son/daughter--grandson/granddaughter). The 3 dogs are shown together (handled separately) to be judged on similarity of type (similar to Brood Bitch & Progeny or Stud Dog & Get). Dogs shown in this class may be neutered/spayed, and breeder(s)/owner(s) do **NOT** need to be identical.

* **Brace Class:** for 2 Bernese Mountain Dogs (not necessarily the same sex) and identical ownership.

* **Stud Dog:** for the stud dog and 2 or more of his get (get do not have to be owned by the same owner as the stud dog)

* **Brood Bitch:** for the brood bitch and 2 or more of her progeny. (not necessarily owned by the same owner)

Sexually Altered: for Bernese Mountain Dogs that have been spayed or neutered.

* **Parade of Veterans:** Dogs must be 7 years of age and older

* dogs in these classes must be entered in one of the Regular Specialty Classes or Exhibition Only

Note: Spayed or Neutered Dogs may enter the Regular Veteran Class and the following Non-Regular classes (provided dog is entered in Exhibition Only): Brace, Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Parade of Veterans, Veteran Sweeps.



DESCRIPTION OF CLASSES (cont...)**Specialty Regular CONFORMATION CLASSES:**

Junior Puppy: for Bernese Mountain Dogs 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show.

Senior Puppy: for Bernese Mountain Dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

12 - 15 Month: (Specialty Shows only) is for Bernese Mountain Dogs 12 months of age and under 15 months of age on the day of the show.

15 - 18 Month: (Specialty Shows only) is for Bernese Mountain Dogs 15 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

Canadian Bred: for Bernese Mountain Dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

Bred By Exhibitor: for Bernese Mountain Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

Open Class: for all Bernese Mountain Dogs.

Veterans (Specialty Shows Only): for Bernese Mountain Dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

Specials Only: for Bernese Mountain Dogs which have a recorded CKC registration or Event Registration Number (ERN) and have attained the required ten (10) points for championship status.

Award of Merit: made after the Best of Breed judging; one Award of Merit may be offered for every 10 dogs competing for Best of Breed.

Exhibition Only: Dogs entered in this category may not compete in any regular classes but may enter non-regular classes.

PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES: Please note that entry fees are payable in Canadian dollars. Personal cheques from US accounts will be accepted; however, they are to be payable for the full amount of the entry. No exchange will be refunded to the entrant. OBEDIENCE CLASSES

NOVICE "A" - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of "CD" in ANY COUNTRY. **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER** or **A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY** and **MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES**. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class, but **MUST COMPETE IN THE NOVICE "B" CLASS**.

NOVICE "B" - This class is open to all dogs which have not earned the title of "CD", and may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog may not necessarily be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class.

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & NOVICE "B" AT THE SAME TRIAL.

OPEN "A" - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of "CDX" in any country. **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER** or **A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY** and **MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES**. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete, but **MUST COMPETE IN THE OPEN "B" CLASS**. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class.

OPEN "B" - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog **MAY ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS**. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A" & OPEN "B" AT THE SAME TRIAL.

UTILITY CLASS - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CDX" in CANADA. This dog may be shown by the owner or any other person. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class.

PLEASE NOTE: The word 'trainer' means any person who conducts or has conducted a dog obedience training class or who regularly assists with the training of dogs in said class or who regularly trains dogs belonging to any person outside his/her immediate family
